NOTE: THIS KIT IS ONLY APPLICABLE TO SINGLE SIDED UNITS.



Accessing The Fireplace


- 1. To access the glass door securing latches, first remove trim kit (if installed) and screen barrier from fireplace.
- 2. Lift the barrier to clear the bottom channel and swing the bottom of the barrier out. Then lower the barrier to clear the top channel.
- 3. Pull forward and upward on the door latch handles to unlatch the door.
- 4. Swing the top of the glass door away from the fireplace at about 15° angle.
- 5. Carefully grip the door at the top and bottom, and remove it from the fireplace. Place the door in a safe location for later re installation.

INSTALLATION

NOTE: The use of gloves is recommended while handling the glass to avoid injury as well to avoid finger prints.

With the fireplace in place and the accessories removed, follow these steps to install the reflective glass liner panels.

1. Open the glass liner kit, identify the glass liner panels; 3 of the same size are for the rear and 2 of the same size are for the left/right sides.



- 2. Loosen screws (do not remove) holding four (4) retaining brackets underneath firebox top. Slide retaining brackets off screws and retain for re-installation (*Figure 2*).
- 3. Install left and right side glass liner panels against sides of firebox and securing with retaining brackets.
- 4. Starting from one side, install three (3) rear glass liner panels by inserting into the firebox bottom channel and securing with retaining brackets (*Figure 2*).
- 5. Clean the glass liner panels with appropriate glass cleaner to remove finger print marks.
- 6. After the installation of reflective glass liner panels, proceed with reinstalling the media kits if removed (glass media, logs, river rocks).
- 7. Retrieve the glass door. Visually inspect the gasket on the backside of the frame. Gasket surface must be clean, free of irregularities and seated firmly.
- 8. Re-install glass door by placing the bottom edge of the door assembly into the door channel on the firebox. The tabs on the bottom of the door on each side will fall into corresponding slots on the door channel of the firebox.
- 9. Re-install the barrier by sliding it upward into the top barrier channel, then push back slightly on the bottom, and lower it into the lower barrier channel.
- 10. Re-install trim assembly if applicable.
