ELECTRICAL GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS This appliance is equipped with a three-prong (grounding) plug for your protection against shock hazard and should be plugged directly into a properly grounded three-prong receptacle. The appliance must be electrically grounded in accordance with local codes or, in the absence of local codes, the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70-(latest edition). (In Canada, the current CSA C22-1 Canadian Electrical Code.)

A WARNING

This kit must be installed by a qualified installer, service agency, or gas supplier. These instructions must be used in conjunction with the installation and operation manual provided with the fireplace.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. To use this replacement blower kit first turn off all power to your appliance.
- 2. Cut the wires to the blower being replaced.
- 3. Note the location of the mounting screws, and remove the old blower and gasket. Discard in a manner suitable to your locality.
- 4. Strip the leads of the wires to the unit, removing approximately 3/8" of insulation per wire.
- 5. Using the previous locations, attach the replacement blower and gasket using the screws, washers, and nuts provided.
- Connect each wire from the new blower to the wires from appliance, using the butt connectors provided. The wires to the blower are not polarity sensitive.
- 7. Turn the power to the appliance back on.
- 8. Confirm that the blower operates.
